### **PUBLIC COMMENT**

Seven residents of Sabin Road spoke at length about problems they're having. Residents at 129 Sabin Road have been hosting Rave parties that last all night. There have been up to 500 kids there and 200 cars lining both sides of the road. It took the NYS troopers over four hours to disperse the crowd a couple of weeks ago. In addition to the noise of the music and the yelling and screaming the kids build bon fires and throw their garbage wherever they please. The residents are also concerned about 2 rottweilers at this residence being vicious and running loose much of the time. They also said that the owner openly burns and has hazardous material on the property. One neighbor fears his well may be contaminated and is having his water tested. The residents also said that between April and October the owner of 196 Sabin Road operates a dog kennel with about 25 dogs. The dogs bark from about 5:30am to 10:00pm making it impossible for the neighbors to enjoy their own homes. Supervisor Haughton promised to contact codes enforcer David Kuehnle, DEC, and the dog control officer Chuck Randall to resolve these problems.

### **SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**

Carl reported that Rob Tyoe returned to work last and Rick Beacraft is scheduled to return next week. Rob has been touching up the paint where needed on the Oshkosh. Jacob Randall has passed all the tests and now has his CDL license. Carl is getting prices on a new pick-up truck. He can get a good trade-in on the 2012 ford.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

Supervisor's meeting: there wasn't a quorum for a meeting but everyone enjoyed the dinner. Danube Supervisor Mosher congratulated Manheim on establishing the Fire District.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

The Fire District needs somewhere to get diesel for the trucks.

**RESOLUTION # 36** Agreement with East Canada Creek Fire District for Diesel Fuel

**RESOLVED** that the Supervisor is hereby authorized to sign the following agreement with the East Canada Creek Fire District to supply them diesel fuel.

### **AGREEMENT**

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this 8<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2016, between the Town of Manheim (hereinafter "Town") with a place of business located at 6356 State Route 167, Dolgeville, New York and the East Canada Creek Fire District (hereinafter "Fire District") with a place of business located at 6356 State Route 167, Dolgeville, New York.

**WHEREAS**, the Fire District has not received the transfer of funds from the Village of Dolgeville required pursuant to the establishment of the Fire District and the dissolution of the Village Fire Department; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Fire District requires and is in the immediate need of diesel fuel to operate certain fire fighting vehicles and equipment; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Manheim Highway Department has diesel fuel stored in tanks at the Highway Department garage in the Town of Manheim; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Manheim Highway Department has sufficient diesel fuel stored on-site such that it could temporarily meet the Fire District's immediate requirements for diesel fuel to operate its firefighting equipment without adversely affecting the operations of the Highway Department,

NOW Therefore, the parties to agree as follows:

- The Town of Manheim agrees to permit the Fire District to request and withdraw from the Town of Manheim Highway Department diesel fuel storage tanks such diesel fuel as it may need to operate its firefighting vehicles and equipment until such time as it receives the transfer of funds from the Village of Dolgeville required pursuant to the establishment of the Fire District and the dissolution of the Village Fire Department.
- The Town of Manheim Superintendent of Highways and the Fire District shall agree upon such forms, recordkeeping and documentation as may be necessary to accurately record the amount of diesel fuel withdrawn by the Fire District Town Highway Department storage tanks and used by the Fire District.
- The Fire District agrees to reimburse the Town of Manheim for the full cost of any diesel fuel obtained from the Town Highway Department pursuant to this agreement within thirty (30) days after receipt of the transfer of funds from the Village of Dolgeville.
