PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Russell and Rob have reported to the county for the summer. Bob and Larry have leaned the yard and started grading some of the roads. Crusher run has been brought in for the summer road projects. The men will be attending 3 more training classes in May. Herkimer County Association of Highway Superintendents will be meeting with Senator Seward next Thursday about the CHIPS program and comments made by Governor Cuomo.

OLD BUSINESS

Supervisor Haughton received conformation that Kyle Wilber of the Office of the Department of State will be attending the May 12, 2015 board meeting to explain the process of establishing a town wide fire district. Board members from Oppenheim, Dolgeville, and the DVFD will be invited to attend.

There was a false alarm at the gas facility Saturday, April 18th. XNG has since met with Town Officials and the Dolgeville Fire Department and proper protocol procedures have been established.

NEW BUSINESS

The town received the final snow plowing payment of \$36,187.17 making the total received \$144,748.65 for 2015; this is up \$3,132.00 from last year and \$2,532.00 over what was budgeted to receive.

\$41,286.88 was received in sales tax money; this is down \$2,549.36 from the same quarter of 2014. \$54,397.37 from the remaining two quarters is needed to meet the budget obligation for Highway DB.
